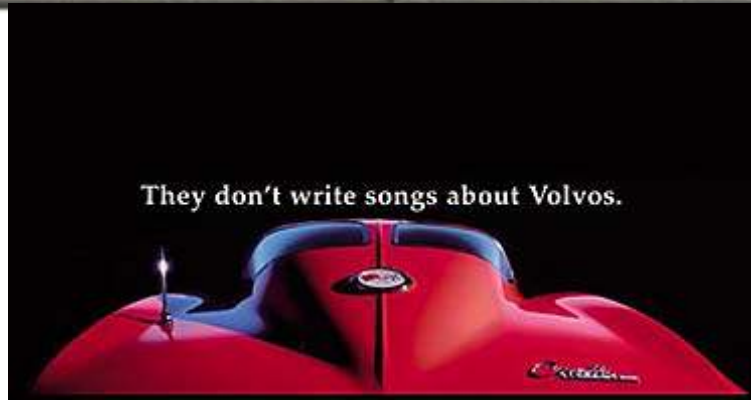
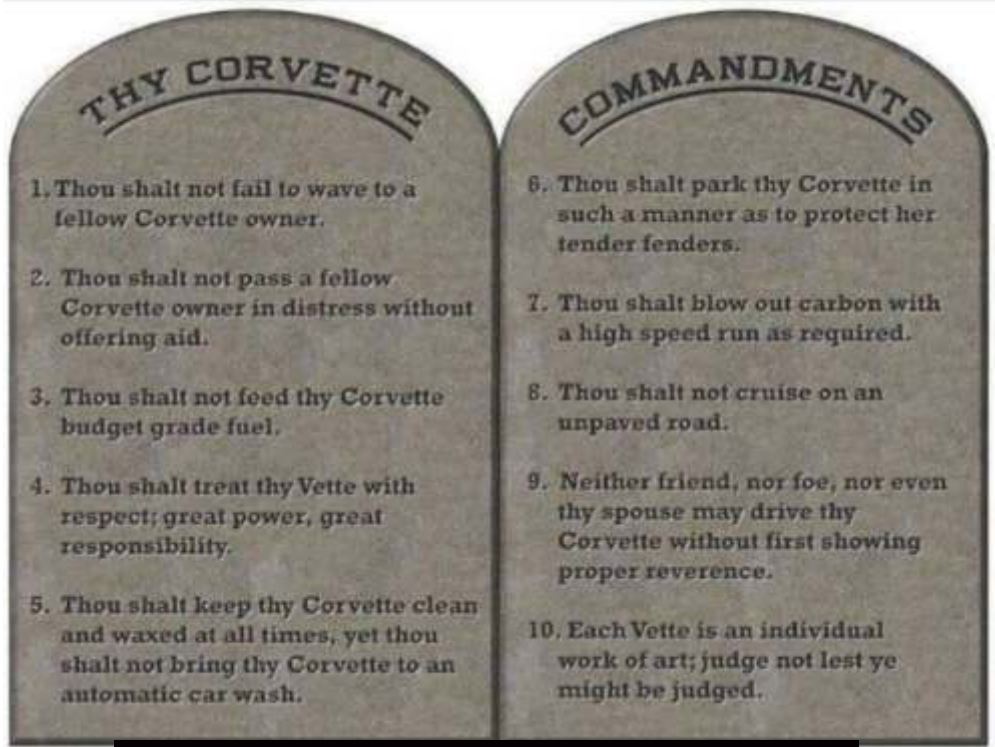
OCTOBER DINNER CRUISE
